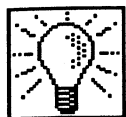
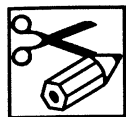


## Comparison Shopping

Leader



Apply appropriate background basics (facts and skills) to make a decision.  
Decisions in comparison shopping are frequently needed.



You will need:

- Advertised prices (from more than one store) of selected items
- A pencil and paper or calculator
- Facts (from a table or from memory) about special measures



Do this:

- From the advertisements (all for the same item) shown here, note:
  - a. the name of the merchandise
  - b. the specific type or brand
  - c. the size(s) offered
  - d. their pricesand then, if all other notes indicate equality, focus on items c and d above.
- List all the sizes.
- List all the prices.
- Discuss a means of changing the “differences” to a “sameness” of size, for a comparison of prices.
- Write out the facts.
- Conclude with a proven answer to the question:
  - Which advertisement offers the best buy?
