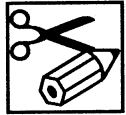


# Pentominoes

- Scissors

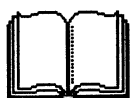


Do this:

- Have students note that each pentomino is made up of five squares.

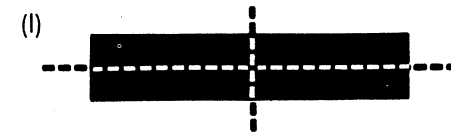
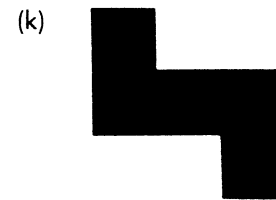
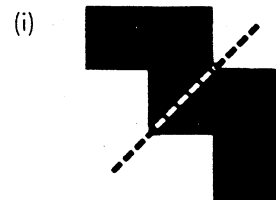
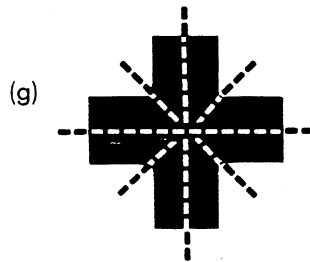
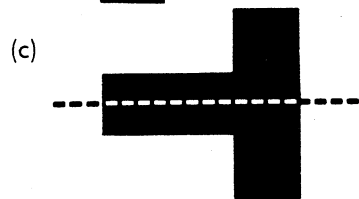
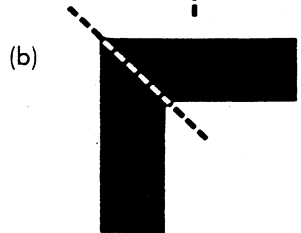


Do this:
